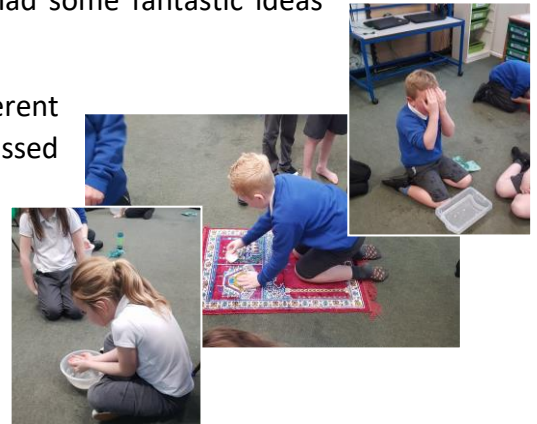

We have been learning about explorers and Alice's adventure in Wonderland in our English lessons and have begun to plan for our own Adventure Stories, using a Story mountain.
