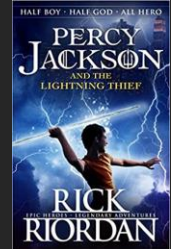
Finally, thank you to everyone who has completed the new, electronic, Parent Questionnaire so far; the form closes automatically at 3.15pm today.

## CLASS WINNERS!

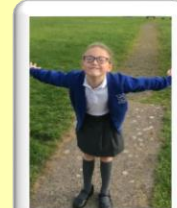
HUGE Congratulations to this week's Class Champions:
