

## **Apply for Free School Meals**

Your child may be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Children who get paid these benefits directly, instead of through a parent or guardian, can also get free school meals.

### **Street Tag**




We are delighted to announce that we have enrolled our school in the Street Tag Schools Leader board Programme. The new season commences on 21<sup>st</sup> April until 20<sup>th</sup> July 2022.

Street Tag is a free, child and family-friendly mobile app which uses virtual tags to incentivise communities and families to become more physically active and boost well-being. This app can be downloaded from the app store or the play store.

Once you have downloaded the app, you will be asked to join our school. To do this you should:

- Click on sign up
- Fill in your details
- Passwords should be 8 characters with 1 special character, 1 upper case and 1 number
- Click YES for Team TR Code
- Scan this QR code and click sign up:
- Verify either by email or phone number
- Fill in the questionnaire and you are ready to go!
