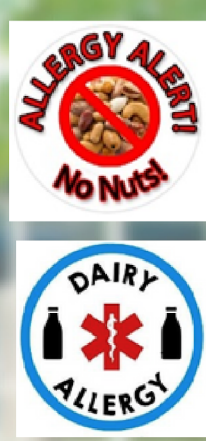

Our headteacher award is always based around our school Christian Values. This half term our Christian Value is: Hope

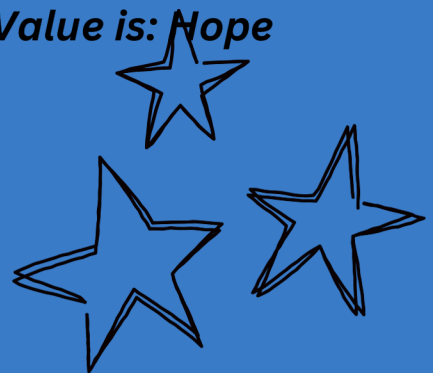

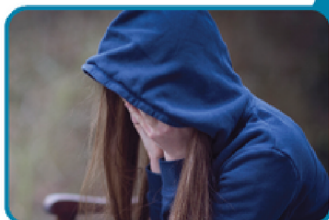
