**Bluebird**- Henry- for the amount of effort and care he has taken over his Charlie and the Chocolate Factory independent write!

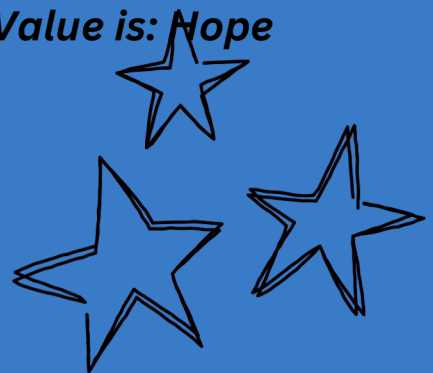
**Wainwright**- for trying so hard to use what we look at in class within your independent writing
