Bluebird- Charlie- for your growing confidence in all areas but especially in Maths. It has been wonderful to see you enjoy your successes.

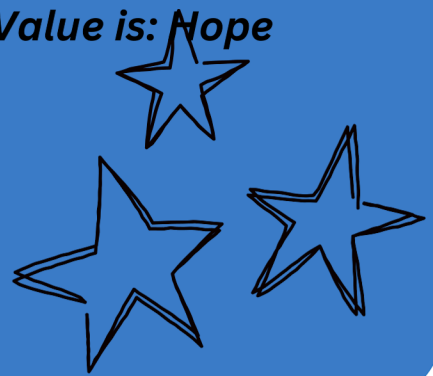
