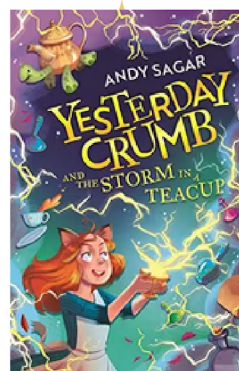


Music Makers: a new creative music club for children aged 7-11
